


FPC Covid-19 Survey

Purpose: Understand impact of COVID-19 on Florida Photonics companies to serve you better


Survey was open May 8, 2020 – May 21, 2020


Are you currently facing **supply chain disruptions** due to the COVID-19 outbreak?



"Most of our work is done remotely from home. Projects that require use of the labs and workshops are done within CDC guidelines and have not created any issues for us."

"Production employees continued to work, most other employees worked from home."

"Taking employees temperature, social distancing, remote workforce" "Employees working remotely from home supplemented with office visits as needed."

"Paycheck Protection Program"

"Sales and technical employees working from home, staggered shifts for product staff."

" Financial assistance such as PPP and EIDL loan from SBA are great." "Stay in contact with customer base to best determine when they will move forward."

" We have lost 50% to 70% of our normal avenue of sales so we started a new division in our company selling PPE (Personal Protection Equipment) such as face masks (nonmedical and medical), hand sanitizers, gloves, face shields, etc

" Methods to determine which of our customers are Essential Businesses and to determine if we can bring the people on site to service them safely."

"Masks, distancing, work station hygiene, minimize person to person communications, no large meetings" "Social distancing, work from home opportunities, zoom meetings, and other advantages in leveraging technology."

"Reducing occupancy by 40 to 45% without letting anyone go or reducing their hours"




